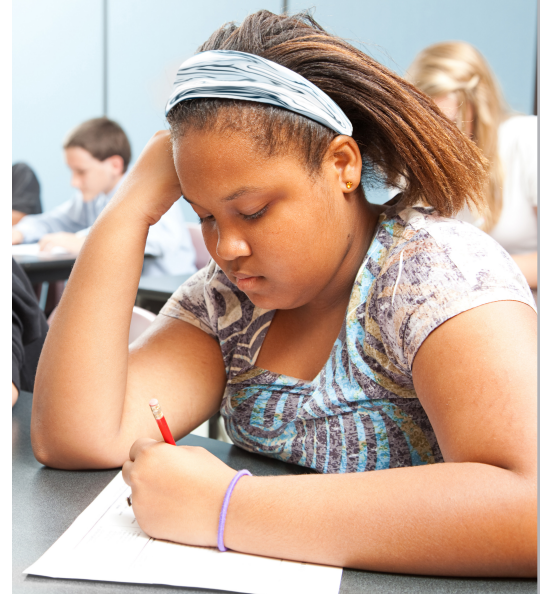


# IS YOUR CHILD HAVING PROBLEMS IN SCHOOL?
